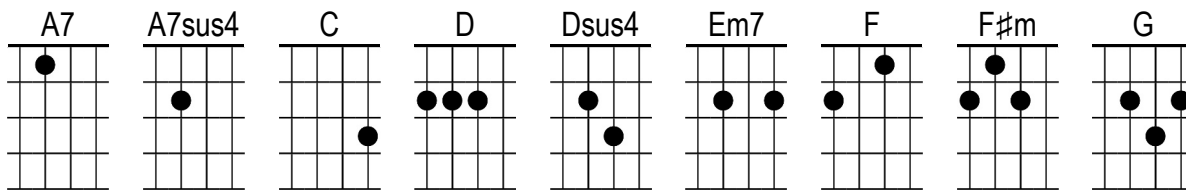


Rock 'N' Roll Song
