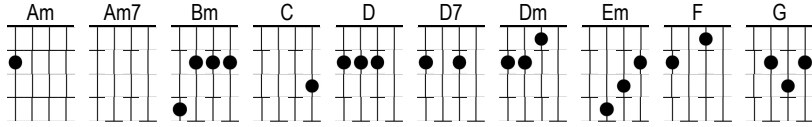


# My Eyes Adored You
