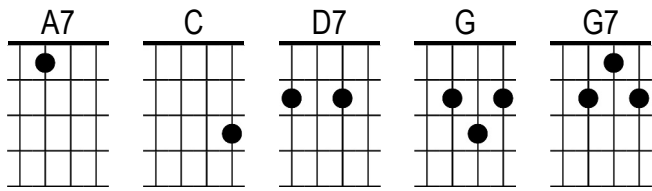


# Wasn't That A Party
