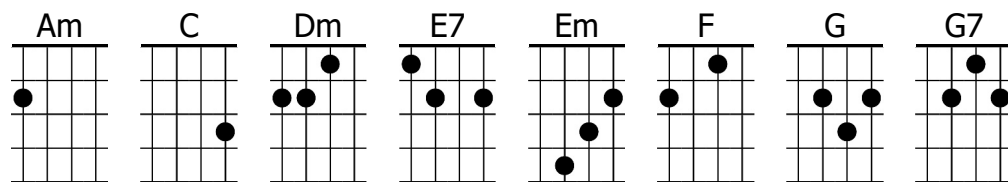


# Yesterday Once More
